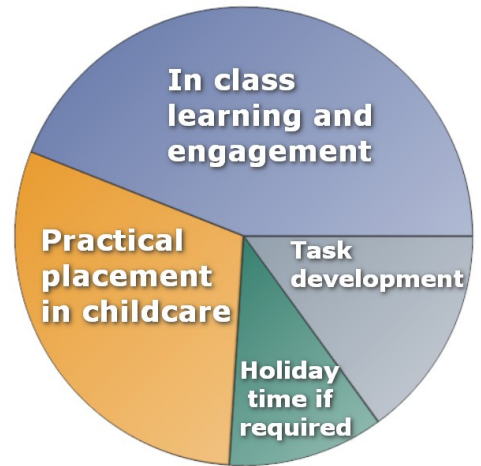

## What is the Certificate III Early Childhood Education and Care?

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of early childhood education settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standards. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children’s wellbeing, learning and development.

**Pre Requisites:** None

**Pathways:** Diploma Early Childhood Education and Care or any other Certificate IV in the Community Services training package.



Childhood educators work in long day care centres, family day care, pre-schools or kindergartens.

To achieve this qualification a total of at least 160 hours of work must be completed in a regulated children’s education and care service.

To assist students balance work, family and other commitments all classes are synchronised with the Western Australian public school terms and holidays.

Classes are scheduled during holiday periods, to ensure that full support and assistance is available if required.
